To become an entrepreneur, there is no need of money but strong will power along with dedication is the main requirement. The challenges of business are defeated by the enthusiasm and passion of the entrepreneur. These are the key points said by Varanasi entrepreneur Mr. Arvind Kumar Maurya regarding his successful venture. The session was organized by the Institutional Innovation Council of Kashi Naresh Government Post Graduate College, Gyanpur Bhadohi on the topic "My Story Motivational Session by Successful Entrepreneurship". While discussing the development journey of his enterprise "Lalji Foods", he told that it started in the year 2006. It was there but it was very slow. In 2012, he left his STF government job and got fully involved in his flavored jaggery enterprise in order to give it a comprehensive look. The result was that this enterprise, established with an initial amount of Rs 300 along with his family members, has grown to a turnover of Rs 8 crore today. He is also providing employment to 80 families by doing a business of Rs. 1000. He got great support from the financial assistance received from the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Scheme. He also shared with the students that now he is expanding his enterprise and making it available on the online platform as well. Before this, the keynote speaker Mr. Arvind Maurya was welcomed by being decorated with a badge and also given a memento. Dr. Jitendra Kumar Maurya introduced the keynote speaker to the students and said that we will share his success story. It is inspiring for everyone. He also told that just a few days ago, in the Udyam Bharat program organized in New Delhi, the Prime Minister had also talked about his venture related to flavored jaggery. The students also satisfied their curiosity by asking questions from the keynote speaker. 

- Prototype – to start creating solutions
- A Design must have peculiarity, utility, ergonomics, safety and Unique selling proposition.
- Prototyping can be done by Better Drawings/ Sketching, Modelling- clay/metal/wood, Cardboard, Assembling ready materials, Rapid Prototyping.
- Rapid prototyping is **the fast fabrication of a physical part, model or assembly using 3D computer aided design (CAD)**. The creation of the part, model or assembly is usually completed using additive manufacturing, or more commonly known as 3D printing.
- Prototypes can be categorised depending on the degree of accuracy required, product development stage, and purpose.

Low-fidelity prototype – Very simple and produced very quickly to test the broader concept. e.g. Paper sketches to cardboard mock-ups

High-fidelity prototype – These prototypes appear and function as similar and closer to the final product.
